## **ELECTIONS OFFICE IS URGING VOTERS DISPLACED BY THE CAMP FIRE TO UPDATE VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

**OROVILLE, CA** – Butte County Clerk-Recorder/Registrar of Voters, Candace J. Grubbs, is urging residents displaced by the November 2018 Camp Fire to update their mailing address with the Registrar of Voters so that they will receive important election materials for upcoming elections.

“We want to help voters who may have been impacted by the Camp Fire understand how to update their voter registration. Depending on what the voter’s intent is will depend greatly on their registration options,” said Candace J. Grubbs, Butte County Clerk-Recorder/Registrar of Voters.

Voters who intend to return to their properties may retain the impacted residence address in order to continue to vote in their original precinct, but will need to update their temporary mailing address on their registration. Voters who do not intend to return to their impacted property address should re-register at their new permanent residence address.
